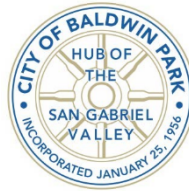

NEW BUSINESS

1. SOC Meeting Minutes of March 10, 2026

It is recommended that the Committee approve the Minutes of the Regular Stakeholders Oversight Committee (SOC) Meetings held on March 10, 2026.

2. Measure BP Sales Tax Financial Update

3. Request Consideration and Approval for Measure BP Funding to continue the NextGen Youth Workforce Program for Summer of 2026

It is recommended that the Stakeholder Oversight Committee approve the following:

1. Consider approving \$105,000 from Measure BP funding for the 2026 NextGen Program if Managed Career Solutions (MCS) "AJCC" is unable to commit funding for the participants through July 31, 2026; and
2. Authorize the use of these funds to:
 - Support 40 program participants under the City's payroll (up to 120 hours per participant, Hourly Rate & Taxes, and City Admin Costs); and
3. Approve the allocation of funds to cover related program expenses, HR cost for pre-employment screening, an Appreciation Lunch with food, refreshments, and city give-a-ways, materials and supplies for a development workshop for the youth participants; and
4. Any remaining funds will be placed back to the Measure BP account.
5. Forward recommendation to the City Council for Consensus and Final Action.

4. Consideration to Allocate Funding for Axon Body-Worn Cameras and In-Car Video System Contract Renewal for Fiscal Years 2026-2031.

It is recommended that the SOC:

1. Approve \$720,612.84 in Measure BP Funding for Axon Body-Worn Camera and In-Car Video System Contract Renewal (FY 2026–2031)
2. Forward to the City Council their recommendation for final approval and appropriation of funds

Note: The City will use ARPA funding that has been obligated to other projects to cover this expenditure. In return, we are seeking that SOC commit to the funding amount to replenish the affected project.
